Affordable Senior Housing for Veterans in the City of Alameda



Expected Move in September 2025!

This is an opportunity for unhoused disabled veterans, who are 62 years or older, to live in a studio or one-bedroom apartment in a great location within the City of Alameda. Linnet Corner is within close walking distance to public transit, grocery stores and other shopping outlets, parks, local employers, and schools. Linnet Corner will open in September.

This newly built housing will offer ten (400-square foot) studio apartments and six (600-square foot) one-bedroom apartments, which will feature individual bathrooms and kitchens, and are suitable for one to three-person households. All rental units are furnished. Resident services are also available onsite, and a free transit pass will be provided to each head of household. Tenants are only responsible for electricity. Other utilities (water, sewer, trash) are provided. A \$500 security deposit is required at move-in.

Monthly rents for studio apartments and one-bedroom apartments will be 30% of income. All Veteran residents will be given a housing voucher. Both honorably and dishonorably charged veterans are eligible to apply. Must be a citizen or legal resident. There is no minimum income limit. Homeless status will be verified. Please do not visit the property site as it is currently under construction.
